At this time no date has been set for a reschedule of the Super Late Model portion of the show.

"Cancelling this event is a heart breaker for us at Montgomery Motor Speedway. Personally, I really was looking forward to seeing Supers and our great Pro Late Model program running the same night", stated Track general manager Stan Narrison. "With the weather forecast being what it is, we wanted to be considerate to our teams and our fans".
